HAZARD RECOGNITION (3 HR. LECTURE)

Wednesday, September 10, 2014 (18:30-21:30) - Wildwood Convention Center

The Hazard Recognition program is designed to deliver the student skills on recognizing the changing of interior fire conditions to prevent possible injury or entrapment. Critical fire ground size-up techniques for interior firefighting operations will include fire behavior, smoke recognition, building construction, situational awareness, mayday/urgent message transmissions, and self-rescue procedures. Case study reviews and previous experiences will be referenced to reinforce the firefighter's recognition skills.

FIRE GROUND SURVIVAL (8 HR. HANDS-ON TRAINING)

Thursday, September 11, 2014 (08:00-16:00) - Wildwood

Any firefighter engaging in interior fire ground operations must have a solid foundation developed in firefighter survival procedures. Rapidly changing conditions could force firefighters to revert to their survival skills within seconds. Students will learn to identify situations that cause firefighters to become injured or trapped, how to take measures to avoid these situations, and learn self-survival procedures. Students will learn various survival techniques from simple to enhanced and then be placed in simulated emergency situations requiring them to apply these survival techniques. Firefighters attending will leave with an increased knowledge of fire ground safety and self-rescue options.
